## **RESEARCH PROMOTION POLICY**

The college is committed to promote a research culture among faculties and students as basic long-term research provides the foundation for future development of the Institution.

#### **Purpose**

The purpose of the Research Policy is to create a vibrant atmosphere of research among faculty and inculcate research aptitude among the students. The policy shall serve as an overall framework within which research activities may be carried out. It also aims to identify thrust areas of research having social relevance and thereby supplementing the vision and mission of the college.

### **Objectives of Research Policy**

The objectives of the Research Policy are as follows:

- 1. To create and promote a culture of research among the faculties and students.
- 2. To identify research areas and specify research topics of academic, practical and socially relevant significance.
- 3. To organize seminars/conferences/workshops on research topics and training programmes in research methodology.
- 4. To ensure quality, integrity and ethics in research.
- 5. To publish research material in appropriate media and to make available such published information to the end users.

#### **Research Policy**

The college shall have a well-defined research policy which shall act as a guideline for the teachers and students.

- The Research Cell of the college shall be responsible for the implementation of research policy
  of the college.
- 2. Research Cell will organize various workshops and seminars to develop appropriate research skills among the students and faculty members.
- Financial assistance will provide by the management for conducting (Complete / Partial)
   (National/ International) conferences, seminars or workshops on the topic Research
   Methodology.
- 4. Research Cell will inform faculty members and students of the college to publish their research articles in National and International Journals.
- 5. Depute faculty members to various workshops, symposia, seminars and conferences in their respective fields as well as in areas of contemporary importance.

- 6. Institution will provide financial assistance for publication of research papers and research findings.
- 7. Three days leave will be granted for faculty members those who are registered PhD in various Universities in India.
- 8. Plagiarism checking is compulsory for M.com project reports. If the percentage of similar content is beyond the permitted limit or plagiarized content is detected, then the students should be given a chance to take appropriate corrective measures.
- 9. Undertake all other such activities which will inculcate research culture in the college.
